## 2018 Estate Pinot Noir

### Vintage Overview

Aromas of Rainier cherry, and fig are central features of this effusive wine, which is comparable in complexity to other Pinot Noirs with 3-4 years of aging. Deep earth-centric flavors concentrate on the forward and mid palate, graduating to a compelling light finish with hints of sarsaparilla tonic.


### In the Vineyard

The 2018 vintage was exceptional in the Willamette Valley. Spring and Summer were unusually warm, but bereft of major heat spikes. However, the harvest was much cooler than the harvests of recent vintages. The diurnal temperature was over 30 degrees, which helped to retain acids and extend hang time.

### In The Winery

Meticulously fermented in small lots, this Pinot Noir was separated by clone and block to enhance each unique characteristic found throughout the vineyard. After 14 months in barrel, the wine was blended to best represent the estate as a whole.
