Vintage Overview

Aromas of nori and an oceanic breeze create the first impressions of this Pinot Gris. Centered and attention grabbing, the mid palate continuously delivers flavors of kumquat and golden delicious apples. Firm umami flavors balance out the tannin structure, and enhance the seriousness of this high tension wine.


In the Vineyard

In 2019, the Northern Willamette Valley saw a return to a more classic cool vintage. Spring was warm and damp with a late bud-break, while the growing season was moderate and steady. Early rains and a rapid October cool down created the need for strategic harvesting of fruit, which rewarded us with optimal ripeness and retention of acidity. From 2019 we may see one of the best vintages in the last two decades.

In the Winery

Two blocks of Pinot Gris were gently pressed and aged on lees. Half of this wine was aged in an Austrian oval oak cask, while the other half was aged in stainless steel for a total of 8 months.
